How and what to submit a presentation proposal

Thank you for taking the time to submit your presentation proposal. Our team will gather all proposals until the deadline; and will then review all of them and select those that we collectively believe would make for the most appropriate and interesting event for our audience. Because we only have a half day event, we unfortunately cannot accept all proposals; and this means we know we will have to decline some very interesting presentations.

In your proposal, please consider the following guidelines:

1. We hope to have a healthy proportion of women and non-binary people as speakers; however, we welcome men to submit their proposals as well.
2. We welcome proposals covering the entire spectrum of cyber, e.g., data protection, cyber security, physical security, security awareness, ... If you are not sure your topic is what we're looking for, submit it anyway!
3. We welcome proposals on any topic of interest to this audience, whether it aims to increase participants' knowledge or motivation for the field.
Examples of topics are technical explanation / demo of a new or often misunderstood technique, analysis, explanation or comparison of a relevant framework or process, personal development story, current trends and future predictions, survey results, academic research, etc.
4. We will not accept any presentations that aim to recruit people to a given organization or that aims to advertise a given product or service.
5. The agenda assumes 20 minute presentations with 10 minutes of Q&A.
6. **The deadline to submit your proposal is Friday, March 31st 2023.**
